Discussion on Proposed Cooperative Sports Expansion for Basketball

Daren Bauer and Joe Bragger reviewed the purpose of the meeting. Each of the Board members were introduced. A presentation was made by each of the Boards regarding the proposed cooperative sports expansion. Questions were asked and a discussion was held on each presentation. Gilmanton presented a 50-50 split for each of the basketball programs. Independence presented a 70-30 split on the boys program but would be open more so to a 50-50 split. For the girls program they would desire a 80-20 split but adjusted to a 75-25 split. Each Board then met separately with their community members to discuss the differences in the proposals from each School Board. The joint session was then resumed. Further discussion was held on the percentages of games for each of the programs. The Independence School Board will have further discussion with their community and give any updates to their proposal prior to March 22, 2022 for the Gilmanton School Board to review. No action was taken.
