Staffing adjustments and work schedules due to COVID-19 and State of Wisconsin Stay at Home Order

The EMERGENCY ORDER #12 SAFER AT HOME ORDER issued by Governor Evers on March 24, 2020 effective March 25, 2020, 8:00 a.m. was reviewed along with its impact on the School District's staffing was discussed.

Diane Ross made the following motion: The School Board of Gilmanton School district authorizes continuation of the reduced workload through the end of the school year for some employees with pay at the regular hourly rate for all hours worked. The Board also issues a furlough (temporary layoff) order for those without work assignments. Even if school classes are not resumed this year, the Board also authorizes continuation of District contributions to insurance premiums to all employees through the summer break (per normal District practice). Those furloughed will become eligible for unemployment compensation benefits, even if working part-time. Employees may opt to take personal leave, vacation, or sick leaves before filing for unemployment compensation. Justin Henthorn seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

Administration reviewed the procedures in place for the delivery of meals and student classroom assignments and materials to the students. No action taken.

Options for Board meetings were discussed. No action taken.
