<u>Resolution 2018 D Authorize Temporary Loans for Operational Expenses</u>: Motion by Jackson Serum, seconded by Diane Ross to authorize the Board to obtain temporary loans for operational expenses if deemed necessary. Motion carried by voice vote.

<u>Resolution 2018 E Disposal of Surplus Property</u>: Motion by Tim Urness, seconded by Kory Rud to authorize the Board to dispose of unused or no longer needed equipment and materials if the Board deems necessary. Motion carried by voice vote.

Resolution 2018 F Authorize Student Accident Insurance for the 2019-2020 School Year: Ellen Urness made a motion which was seconded by Jackson Serum to provided student accident insurance for the 2019-2020 school year. Motion carried by voice vote.

<u>Resolution 2018 G Authorize Board to Defend Legally</u>: Motion by Tim Urness, seconded by Diane Ross to authorize the School Board to legally defend the District and its interests. Motion carried by voice vote.
